**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 85 OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 47-2013, IMPOSING A FEE IN FAVOR OF APPLICANTS FOR TRUCK BAN EXEMPTIONS, AUTHORIZING THE DEPOSIT OF THE SAID FEES IN THE SPECIAL ACCOUNT OF THE BACOR TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS HEREOF.**

**WHEREAS**, Sections 134, 142, 151 and 152 of Republic Act No. 7160 (the "Local Government Code of 1991") allow provinces, cities, municipalities and barangays to impose and collect taxes, fees and charges on business and occupation and on the practice of any profession and calling.

**WHEREAS**, Section 151 in relation to Section 147 of RA 7160 provides that fees and charges imposed by cities should be reasonable and commensurate with the cost of regulation, inspection and licensing before any person may engage in such business or occupation, or practice of such profession or calling. Furthermore, Article 233 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of RA 7160 provides that no such fee or charge shall be based on capital investment or gross sales or receipts of the person or business liable therefore.

**WHEREAS**, Section 5 of Republic Act No. 11032 (the "Ease of Doing Business and Efficient Government Service Delivery Act") provides that all proposed regulations of government agencies under Section 3 of the same Act shall undergo regulatory impact assessment to establish if the proposed regulation does not add undue regulatory burden and cost to these agencies and the applicants or requesting parties.

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) and the Department of Finance (DOF) issued Joint Memorandum Circular No. 01- 2019 on 17 May 2019 (GUIDELINES FOR THE REVIEW, ADJUSTMENT, SETTING AND/OR ADOPTION OF REASONABLE REGULATORY FEES AND CHARGES OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS) for the purpose of guiding local government units in using uniform procedures in setting

reasonable fees and charges in the course of implementing the aforesaid provisions of RA 7160 and RA 10132.

**WHEREAS**, the Sangguniang Panlungsod approved City Ordinance No. 47-2013 (the "Revised Traffic Code of the City of Bacoor") on 7 October 2013.

**WHEREAS**, Sections 85 and 85.1 of City Ordinance No. 47-2013 provides that:

**"Section 85. Truck Ban.** - No cargo truck shall be allowed to travel or pass along Evangelista Road Aguinaldo Highway, Daang Hari, Molino Boulevard, and Tirona Highway within the territorial jurisdiction of Bacoor, Cavite from 5:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and from 3:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. everyday except Sundays and Holidays. No cargo trucks shall be allowed to travel or pass along Zapote-Salawag Road from the junction of Daang-hari to Zapote, Bacoor, Cavite every day.

**85.1. Truck Ban Exemptions** -Subject to guidelines to be determined by the City Mayor truck ban conduct passes shall be granted to the following on a limited basis:

- a) Heavy vehicles delivering petroleum products;
- b) Heavy vehicles undertaking international messengerial or package delivery services;
- c) Heavy vehicles utilized as garbage trucks by the City Government or by other local government units. Provided, that trucks carrying the garbage of other local government units shall only be allowed to pass or use the following roads: Aguinaldo Highway, Daang Hari Zapote-Salawag (from Daang-hari intersection to Salawag) and Coastal Road;
- d) Emergency vehicles of power and water companies;
- e) Heavy vehicles being utilized by the government in the construction of infrastructure projects subject to the issuance of a valid certification and trip pass by the government authority concerned such as DPWH.DOTC, LGUs PEA, et.al.,
- f) Heavy vehicles carrying perishable goods in commercial quantity, and
- g) Armored and marked vehicles."

**WHEREAS**, the City Mayor, Hon. Strike B. Revilla, formally requested the Sangguniang Panlungsod to pass an ordinance amending the afore-quoted provisions of the Revised Traffic Code in view of the growing number of requests from business owners for exemption which, if approved, might lead to significant improvement in the local economy but might also cause damage to public roads and contribute to traffic congestion in the City of Bacoor.

**WHEREAS**, public hearings were conducted by the Sangguniang Panlungsod on the said request.

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bacoor, Cavite THAT:

**Section 1. Amendments to Sections 85 of City Ordinance No. 47-2013.** Section 85 of City Ordinance No. 47-2013 and its sub-sections are hereby amended as follows:

**"Section 85. Truck Ban.** - No cargo truck shall be allowed to travel or pass along Evangelista Road Aguinaldo Highway, Daang Hari, Molino Boulevard, and Tirona Highway within the territorial jurisdiction of Bacoor, Cavite from 5:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and from 3:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. everyday except Sundays and Holidays. No cargo truck shall be allowed to travel or pass along Zapote-Salawag Road from the junction of Daang-Hari to Zapote, Bacoor City, Cavite every day.

**85.1. Truck Ban Exemptions** -Subject to guidelines to be determined by the City Mayor truck ban conduct passes shall be granted to the following on a limited basis:

- a) Heavy vehicles delivering petroleum products;
- b) Heavy vehicles undertaking international messengerial or package delivery services;
- c) Heavy vehicles utilized as garbage trucks by the City Government or by other local government units. Provided, that trucks carrying the garbage of other local government units shall only be allowed to pass or use the following roads: Aguinaldo Highway, Daang Hari Zapote-Salawag (from Daang-hari intersection to Salawag) and Coastal Road;
- d) Emergency vehicles of power, water, telecommunication and other public utility companies;
- e) Heavy vehicles being utilized by the government in the construction of infrastructure projects subject to the issuance of a valid certification and trip pass by the government authority concerned such as DPWH, DOTC, LGUs, PEA, et al
- f) Heavy vehicles carrying perishable goods in commercial quantity.
- g) Armored and marked vehicles; and
- h) Privately owned trucks whose registered owners have paid the Truck Ban Exemption Fee provided below.

**85.2. Truck Ban Exemption Fee.** — Privately owned trucks whose registered owners have paid an annual truck ban exemption fee of Ten Thousand Pesos (P10,000.00) shall be issued a Truck Ban Exemption sticker which shall be prominently displayed on the windshield of the said truck in compliance with the Implementing Rules and

Regulations to be approved by the City Mayor with regard to this Section.

**85.3. Authority to Deposit Truck Ban Exemption Fee in the Special Account of the BTMD.** — All Truck Ban Exemption fees collected by virtue of this Section shall be deposited in the special account of the Bacoor Traffic Management Department and shall be used exclusively for the purposes for which the said account was created as mandated by law or any pertinent city ordinance."

**Section 2. Separability Clause.** In case any provision of this ordinance is declared void or unconstitutional by a court of law, the remaining provisions hereof not affected by such declaration shall remain valid and enforceable.

**Section 3. Effectivity.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately after it has been published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation within the City of Bacoor, Cavite and after a copy thereof has been submitted with the University of the Philippines-Office of the National Administrative Register (UP-ONAR).
