A RESOLUTION CREATING THE BARANGAY BOUNDARY DISPUTES RESOLUTION (BBDR) TASK FORCE OF THE CITY OF BACOOR.

WHEREAS, the City Government is in need of a data-gathering team that will establish the current and updated markers, in accordance with the recently approved cadastral/barangay boundary index maps (BBIMs) in line with its efforts to provide assistance to various barangays with unresolved boundary disputes in the City of Bacoor.

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Mayor requested the Sangguniang Panlungsod to create a special body tasked with the duty of providing technical assistance to the city council in resolving barangay boundary disputes.

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod deliberated on the request of the Office of the City Mayor and unanimously agreed to create an ad hoc body to be known and referred to as the Barangay Boundary Disputes Resolution (BBDR) Task Force to manage data-gathering and to conduct Inter-Barangay Mediation Proceedings which will also be required to thoroughly explain to concerned disputing barangays the actual and approved boundaries based on the said Index Maps (BBIMs).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Sangguniang Panlungsod, in regular session assembled that:

Section 1. An ad hoc composite body jointly under the control and supervision of the Office of the City Mayor and of the Sangguniang Panlungsod is hereby created to be known as the **Barangay Boundary Disputes Resolution (BBDR) Task Force** (the "Task Force") of the City of Bacoor.

Section 2. The Task Force shall be comprised of the following:

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3.1. Conduct data gathering related to the resolution of barangay boundary disputes;

3.2. Conduct geodetic surveys, studies or research work related to the accomplishment of its various functions;

3.3. Advise and provide technical support to the Sangguniang Panlungsod, the City Mayor, and the Punong Barangay of the various barangays with boundary disputes about the result of its survey, study or research related to the said dispute;

3.4. Summon resource persons related to the accomplishment of its various functions; and

3.5. Submit a detailed written recommendation to the Sangguniang Panlungsod and to the City Mayor on how to resolve barangay boundary disputes in accordance with law.

Section 4. The Task Force shall only exist for a period of three (3) months from the date of approval of this Resolution and shall automatically cease to exist upon the expiration of the said period, **Provided**, that the Task Force shall convene on **23 February 2017** and immediately begin its work in view of the transcendental importance of resolving all existing barangay boundary disputes as soon as possible to the future of the City of Bacoor and to the timely completion of the various programs of the city government.

Section 5. The members of the Task Force shall not be entitled to any additional salary, allowance or remuneration.

Section 6. Any ordinance, resolution, or executive order in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed or modified.

Section 7. The appropriate administrative penalties shall be imposed against city government employee or official who violates this Resolution.

Section 8. The City Mayor, the Punong Barangay of all the barangays of the City of Bacoor, and all other government offices and agencies concerned shall be furnished with copies of this Resolution.
