A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. LANI MERCADO-REVILLA, TO SIGN AND ENTER INTO MEMORANDA OF AGREEMENT AMONG THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR, THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES (DENR), AND 18 BARANGAYS IN THE CITY OF BACOOR, CAVITE REGARDING THE COMPREHENSIVE CLEAN-UP ALONG THE ZAPOTE RIVER SYSTEM WITHIN THE CITY OF BACOOR.

WHEREAS, the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) is the primary government agency responsible for the conservation, management, development and proper use of the country's natural resources;

WHEREAS, DENR Administrative Order No. 16, Series of 2019, entitled: "Expediting the Rehabilitation and Restoration of the Coastal Marine Ecosystem of the Manila Bay and Creating Manila Bay Task Force" directs the convergence of the national government agencies and the LGUs in the Manila Bay Region that includes the Province of Cavite and the active participation of private and public stakeholders which are necessary to facilitate the robust and integrated implementation of all the rehabilitation efforts at the Manila Bay;

WHEREAS, the DENR will provide **Six Hundred Thousand Pesos (PhP600,000.00)** or 60% of the total budget of PhP1,000,000.00 to each barangay for the conduct of weekly clean-up activities and the remaining **Four Hundred Thousand Pesos (PhP400,000.00)** or 40% of the total budget of PhP1,000,000.00 will be given to the city government for the hauling and disposal of collected waste during the clean-up of the Zapote River.

WHEREAS, a draft Memorandum of Agreement was submitted by the Office of the City Mayor to the Sangguniang Panlungsod for review and consideration;

NOW THEREFORE, upon motion of Hon. Reynaldo D. Palabrica duly seconded by Hon. Victorio L. Guerrero, Jr. in regular session duly assembled **BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Sangguniang Panlungsod to authorize the City Mayor, Hon. Lani Mercado-Revilla, to sign and enter into Memoranda of Agreement among the City Government of Bacoor, the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) and the 18 aforementioned Barangays regarding the comprehensive clean-up along the Zapote River System within the City of Bacoor.

RESOLVED LASTLY, to furnish the Office of the City Mayor, the DENR, the 18 aforementioned Barangays, and other government agencies concerned with copies of this resolution.

UNANIMOUSLY ADOPTED this 18th day of November 2019 at the City of Bacoor during the 19th regular session of the 4th Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bacoor.
