A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, TO SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (DepEd), CITY SCHOOLS DIVISION OF BACOOR, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR REGARDING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SCHOOL ADVOCACY PROGRAMS, SPIRITUAL, ARTISTIC, SOCIO-CIVIC PROGRAMS AND OTHER YOUTH FORMATION PROGRAMS TO ADDRESS THE RISING NUMBER OF CRIMES COMMITTED WITHIN THE CITY OF BACOOR.

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Mayor sent a letter to the Sangguniang Panlungsod requesting to pass a resolution authorizing the City Mayor, Hon. Strike B. Revilla, to sign a Memorandum of Agreement with the Department of Education (DepEd), City Schools Division of Bacoor regarding the implementation of school advocacy programs, spiritual, artistic, socio-civic programs and other youth formation programs to address the rising number of crimes being committed within the City of Bacoor.

WHEREAS, the City Social Welfare and Development Office reported that from December 5, 2022 to April 18, 2023, 2,041 persons have been apprehended by police and barangay officials for allegedly violating the curfew within the City of Bacoor. Out of the said number, 1,486 of them were minors.

WHEREAS, the City Government of Bacoor is concerned about the said report and it intends to coordinate with various schools in Bacoor City through the DepEd in order to help the community in reforming youth offenders.

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Mayor submitted a draft Memorandum of Agreement between the City Government of Bacoor and the City Schools Division of

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Agreement (the "Agreement") is made and entered into this _____ day of _____ 20__ (the "Effective Date") in Bacoor City, Province of Cavite, by and between:

The **CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR**, a local government unit created and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal office and postal address at Bacoor Government Center, Bacoor Boulevard, Barangay Bayanan, Bacoor City, Cavite, represented herein by its City Mayor, **Hon. STRIKE B. REVILLA**, pursuant to his authority conferred and embodied in City Resolution No. _____, Series of _____, approved _____ of the City Council of Bacoor City, Cavite, and hereinafter referred to as "**LGU BACOOR**"

and

The **DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, CITY SCHOOLS DIVISION OF BACOOR**, a government entity directly attached with the Department of Education, with principal office and postal address at DepEd Building, Bacoor Government Center, Bacoor Boulevard, Barangay Bayanan, Bacoor City, Cavite, represented by herein by the OIC - Schools Division Superintendent, **Dr. BABYLYN M. PAMBID, CESO V**, and hereinafter referred to as the "**DEPED BACOOR**"

The term "Party" shall refer to LGU BACOOR or DEPED BACOOR, if applicable, while the term "Parties" shall refer to LGU BACOOR and DEPED BACOOR, collectively.

Witnesseth that:

WHEREAS, the State has an inherent power to promote public welfare by restraining and regulating the use of liberty and property. As an inherent attribute of sovereignty which virtually extends to all public needs, police power grants a wide array of instruments through which the State, as *parens patriae*, gives effect to a host of its regulatory powers;

WHEREAS, LGU BACOOR as a local government unit of the State is delegated with police power to which it can exercise within its jurisdiction to protect its residents, most especially the youth, to provide a safe space for them and protect them from rampant criminality happening around and within its city;

WHEREAS, on 04 October 2002, City Ordinance No. 7 S-2002 was enacted amending the Code of General Ordinances regarding curfew for minors;

WHEREAS, since the enactment of the said City Ordinance based on a data submitted by the Bacoor City Social Welfare and Development Office, an alarming discovery was made that for the period from 05 December 2022 to 18 April 2023 alone, twenty thousand forty-one (2041) violators have been apprehended, and one thousand four hundred eighty-six (1486) of which were minors. Most of these minors who violated the said City Ordinance were habitual offenders;

WHEREAS, LGU BACOOR is greatly concerned with the data submitted to it, and wishes to have the full implementation of the said City Ordinance and create a partnership

with the schools and other local facilities in helping the community in reforming these minors, and to ensure that they would obey curfew rules at all times;

WHEREAS, LGU BACCOOR seeks the assistance of DEPED BACCOOR to aid and assist in creating school advocacy programs, spiritual program, artistic programs, socio-civic programs and other youth formation programs for the Bacoor City Youth in order to ensure the reformation of these minors, and not to violate curfews anymore (the "Programs"), as these minors' safety is the priority of LGU BACCOOR considering the rising number of criminalities happening within and around the city;

WHEREAS, DEPED BACCOOR agrees to lend hand in the creation and implementation of these Programs;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the premises and covenants, hereinafter states, the Parties hereto have agreed and do hereby agree as follows:

1. DEPED BACCOOR agrees to coordinate with all public and private schools within the City of Bacoor, and make a proposal with LGU BACCOOR of programs which would help the latter achieving the purpose of this Agreement;
2. The DEPED BACCOOR agrees to present the proposal before LGU BACCOOR within a period of **fifteen (15) days** to commence from the Effective Date of this Agreement;
3. Once approved, DEPED BACCOOR, in coordination with all the schools within the City of Bacoor, agrees to implement the Programs meticulously and systematically within the schools and other facilities;
4. LGU BACCOOR undertakes to provide funding for the implementation of the Programs, if found reasonable after the presentation of the proposal from DEPED BACCOOR;
5. DEPED BACCOOR undertakes to dutifully submit a progress report to LGU BACCOOR on a **quarterly basis**;
6. This Agreement may be a subject of amendment if both parties deemed fit in order to create and strengthen a youth program for the reformation and protection of minors who violated the curfew. This Agreement may not be modified except in writing signed by the duly authorized representatives of the Parties after reasonable negotiations and discussion.
7. Unless otherwise terminated as provided herein, this Agreement shall commence to take effect on the Effective Date as abovementioned until both Parties may deem fit. Either Party may terminate this Agreement without cause by written notice to the other Party at least thirty (30) days prior to the intended date of termination. Pre-termination by either Party under this section shall be based only on valid and equitable grounds.
8. Each Party represents and warrants on its own behalf that the individual signing this Agreement on its behalf is fully authorized to sign on behalf of and bind it, and that it has the power and authority to enter into it. The Parties further warrant that they have read and understood this Agreement and bind themselves to its full and proper execution.
