**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, TO SIGN THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR AND UNIVERSITY OF PERPETUAL HELP SYSTEM DALTA FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE STRIKE B. REVILLA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM.**

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, empowers the City Government to enter into partnerships with educational institutions for the purpose of providing assistance to qualified students.

**WHEREAS**, on 15 May 2023, the Sangguniang Panlungsod received a letter from the Office of the Mayor requesting authority to sign a Memorandum of Agreement with the University of Perpetual Help System Dalta for the Strike B. Revilla Scholarship Program.

This proposed Memorandum of Agreement is incorporated and made an integral part of this Resolution.

**WHEREAS**, the proposed Memorandum of Agreement stipulates that grantees of the scholarship program shall receive a 100% scholarship on their tuition fees. Additionally, the program places priority on certain courses at the University, such as Architecture, Business Administration, Computer Studies, Mass Communication, Education, and Criminology.

**WHEREAS**, the advancement of education is a national priority. By establishing the Strike B. Revilla Scholarship Program, the City of Bacoor is showing its commitment to the pursuit of knowledge, furthering national development, and addressing the educational needs of its constituents.

**WHEREAS**, the Strike B. Revilla Scholarship Program represents an investment in the future of Bacoor, as it supports the education of the city's promising young citizens, preparing them to contribute significantly to local industries and governance, and further strengthening the social and economic fabric of our city.

**WHEREAS**, the creation of scholarships is a critical element of social justice. Education, though enjoyed privately, serves as a public good. It fosters social mobility, decreases income inequality, and promotes civic participation.

**WHEREAS**, the establishment of scholarships aligns with the mandate given under Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 or the Local Government Code of 1991 to exercise all powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental to the promotion of the general welfare. The provision of educational opportunities not only benefits the individual recipient, but also has a profound effect on the community at large. It fosters a well-educated populace, capable of contributing to the economic growth, social cohesion, and general welfare of the City of Bacoor.

**WHEREAS**, it is essential to finance scholars and encourage the youth to pursue the priority courses. These fields of study equip our youth with the skills and knowledge necessary to meet the city's evolving needs, promote local industry, foster innovation, and contribute to the sustainable development of Bacoor.

**WHEREAS**, under the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the city in all its business transactions and sign on its behalf all contracts upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod. Moreover, no contract may be entered into by the local chief executive without the Sangguniang Panlungsod's prior authorization.

**STRIKE B. REVILLA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM  
MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT  
CITY OF BACOR and UNIVERSITY OF PERPETUAL HELP SYSTEM DALTA**

**KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:**

This Memorandum of Agreement (MOA, for brevity) is entered into this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ 2023, at City of Bacoor by and between:

The **UNIVERSITY OF PERPETUAL HELP SYSTEM DALTA**, is a private educational institution of higher learning established under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines represented herein by its President, DR. ANTHONY JOSE M. TAMAYO, and hereinafter referred to as "UPHSD";

-and-

The **CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOR**, a local government unit with office address at Bacoor Government Center, Brgy. Bayanan, Tabing Dagat, Bacoor City, Cavite, represented herein by its City Mayor, **STRIKE B. REVILLA**, pursuant to his authority conferred and embodied in City Resolution **CR No.** \_\_\_\_\_, a copy of which is attached hereto and hereinafter referred to as "CITY".

**1. PROGRAM COVERAGE**

This MOA contains the Scholarship Program applicable to qualified individuals who are constituents of the City of Bacoor, and the mechanics and procedures for its availment also known as its Implementing Rules and Regulations.

**2. PURPOSE**

This Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) prescribes the policies and procedures governing the implementation of the City of Bacoor-UPHSD Scholarship Program for SY 2023-2024 and the succeeding years thereafter:

- a. Management and organization of the educational benefits program;
- b. Selection and administration of grantees; and
- c. Statement of requirements and responsibilities of those availing the educational benefits.

**3. SCOPE AND LIMITATIONS**

This IRR prescribes the rules and regulations governing the implementation of the City of Bacoor-UPHSD Scholarship Program and applies only to qualified scholars who are residents of the City of Bacoor.

#### 4. DEFINITION OF TERMS

For the purpose of this IRR, the following terms shall mean and be understood as indicated:

- a. **Grantee** – Qualified scholar who is the recipient of the scholarship grant.
- b. **Educational Benefits Grant** – Educational undertaking provided by the City of Bacoor and UPHSD to support the education of the grantee.
- c. **Tuition and Miscellaneous Fees** – Fees collected by the UPHSD to be used in paying for the grantee's processing, registration, enrollment and other related fees.

#### 5. POLICIES

For the purposes of implementing the City of Bacoor-UPHSD Scholarship Program, the following policies are hereby enumerated:

##### A. GENERAL

1. **Program Coverage.** This Scholarship Program shall apply only on priority courses of UPHSD-Molino Campus under the following Colleges:
  - a. Architecture
  - b. Business Administration
  - c. Computer Studies
  - d. Mass Communication
  - e. Education
  - f. Criminology

2. **Program Beneficiaries and Benefits.**

This Scholarship Program shall cover the scholar's tuition fees every semester for an undergraduate priority course of UPHSD-Molino Campus under any of the above-enumerated Colleges, and in particular as follows:

- UPHSD – 100% Scholarship on Tuition Fees
- Student Account – Miscellaneous Fees

3. **Program Priority.** This Scholarship Program gives priority to individuals with the following basic qualifications:

- 3.1 Twenty (20) residents of City of Bacoor
- 3.2 Must pass the screening of the scholarship Coordinator of the City of Bacoor.
- 3.3 Must have no failing grades
- 3.4 Must submit the requirements set by the City of Bacoor and UPHSD
- 3.5 Must have completed duty hours from previous grant (for old grantees)

#### 4. Education Benefit Grant Administration

- 4.1 Applicants for this educational benefit program shall be accepted at the start of every semester of the applicable school year.
- 4.2 Applicants for this scholarship program must satisfy all admission requirements set by the UPHSD the school year applied,
- 4.3 The City of Bacoor shall process and thereafter, recommend to UPHSD all approved applicants for scholarship program to undertake admission examinations and other admission procedures.
- 4.4 Thereafter, the applicants must satisfy the admission requirements set by UPHSD, as follows;
  - 4.4.1 Must have a GWA of 95% belonging to a class of 30
  - 4.4.2 Certificate of Good Moral endorsed by the school certifying the GWA and class size
  - 4.4.3 Endorsement Letter from the Bacoor Mayor's Office
- 4.5 The UPHSD shall submit to City of Bacoor the list of the successful applicant who have passed the admission requirements and thereafter, admitted to the City of Bacoor UPHSD Scholarship Program.
- 4.6 A grantee is entitled to an educational benefit grant leading to one baccalaureate degree from UPHSD
- 4.7 Grantees shall not be allowed to shift another course during the duration of the scholarship grant unless approved by both the City of Bacoor and UPHSD. In case the grantee shifts to another course, the basis for the term of the grant will be on the number of years specified in the curriculum of the originally chosen course.
- 4.8 The Educational Scholarship obligation shall commence immediately on the year the grantee enrolls his/her course.
- 4.9 The grantees are required to render 100 duty hours for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year and 50 hours for 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> year of clerical works to be performed in any assigned offices. Duty hours should be rendered during the semester where the scholarship is granted.
- 4.10 The grantee admitted in the program shall abide by the rules and regulations set by the City of Bacoor and UPHSD as well as the course requirements.
- 4.11 The grantee shall be governed by the policies and educational standards of the UPHSD. Breach of the same shall mean forfeiture of the scholarship program.
- 4.12 At no instance shall a grantee be allowed to go on leave of absence (LOA) from course/ program without prior approval from the City of Bacoor. If approved, the City of Bacoor will communicate the approved LOA to UPHSD for consideration. Scholarship for approved LOA will be suspended and subject for reconsideration of the City of Bacoor if they will still be considered as scholars when he/she returned.
- 4.13 The educational benefits grant shall be terminated if: (a) the grantee fails to meet all requirements – academic, behavioral, and economic – set by the UPHSD and City of Bacoor (b) is expelled from the UPHSD or (c) is convicted by any crime involving moral turpitude.

- C. Thereafter, the UPHSD shall submit to the City of Bacoor the names of candidates who have successfully passed the admission examinations.
- D. Both parties shall come up with a list of approved grantees at the start of every semester.
- E. Upon submission of Certification of Grades, the City of Bacoor shall issue a continuance letter to the grantee to be presented to UPHSD upon enrollment.
- F. The UPHSD shall continue the provision of the scholarship grant provided that the grantees present the continuance letter issued by the City of Bacoor upon enrollment.
- G. Upon completion of the course, all grantees under this educational benefit program are required to submit to City of Bacoor a certified true copy of all grantees' diploma/certificate of completion of records.

**EFFECTIVITY**

This Implementing Rules and Regulations governing the City of Bacoor – UPHSD Scholarship Program shall be implemented after signing of MOA or IRR.

This MOA supersedes and repeals any other agreement, contract and/or understanding containing the same and/or similar subject matter, unless said existing agreement, contract and/or understanding, if there be any, is expressly mentioned in this MOA or in any other writing, to still exist vis-avis this MOA.
