RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, TO SIGN THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOR AND BARANGAY MOLINO IV FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT, OPERATION, AND MANAGEMENT OF STRIKE! SENIOR CITIZENS CENTER IN THE SAID BARANGAY.

WHEREAS, international law also recognizes the rights and welfare of senior citizens, as reflected in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and the United Nations Principles for Older Persons (accessible at <https://www.ohchr.org>), emphasizing the need for societies to ensure the full participation, independence, and dignity of senior citizens.

WHEREAS, protecting and supporting senior citizens contribute to the overall well-being and development of society. This is because senior citizens possess a wealth of knowledge, experiences, and wisdom that can be harnessed for the betterment of the community.

WHEREAS, the same is also a moral imperative considering the years of service that senior citizens have provided to the community as productive members of society.

WHEREAS, participative governance is crucial in building an inclusive and democratic society. It is imperative to include senior citizens in the policy-making process to ensure their voices are heard, their concerns are addressed, and their contributions are valued.

WHEREAS, providing support for the activities of senior citizens and senior citizen associations fosters social engagement, promotes healthy aging, and strengthens the sense of belonging and camaraderie among senior citizens.

WHEREAS, offering counseling services to senior citizens and senior citizen associations is essential to address their specific needs, provide guidance, and assist in the successful conduct of their activities.

WHEREAS, creating a senior citizen center not only enhances the self-efficacy and empowerment of senior citizens and senior citizen associations but also promotes social inclusion, intergenerational harmony, and the overall well-being of the community.

WHEREAS, the Barangay Government of Molino IV is interested in working with the City Government of Bacoor to establish a senior citizen center named STRIKE! Senior Citizen Center in the vicinity of Molino IV.

The proposed Memorandum of Agreement containing the details of this partnership is incorporated and is deemed an integral part of this Resolution.

WHEREAS, under the proposed Memorandum of Agreement, the Barangay Government of Molino IV and the City Government of Bacoor have agreed to collaborate in establishing the STRIKE! Senior Citizen Center, which will serve as a hub for senior citizens' activities and as a resource for immediate assistance in case of accidents or health concerns.

WHEREAS, establishing a senior citizen center, such as the proposed STRIKE! Senior Citizen Center, will serve as a dedicated space to support the activities of senior citizens, provide counseling services tailored to their needs, and facilitate their greater participation in the policy-making process.

WHEREAS, the establishment of the STRIKE! Senior Citizen Center aligns with the directive of the Department of the Interior and Local Government, particularly DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2019-81, which urges all government agencies and local government units to develop and implement plans and programs that enhance the living conditions and well-being of senior citizens.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, also known as the Local Government Code of 1991, promoting the general welfare of the public is one of

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
FOR THE OPERATION AND MANAGEMENT OF
STRIKE! SENIOR CITIZENS CENTER SA BARANGAY MOLINO IV, BACOR CITY,
CAVITE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Agreement ("AGREEMENT") is made and entered this ____ day of _____, 20__ in Bacoor City, Province of Cavite by and between:

The **CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOR**, a local government unit created and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal office and postal address at Bacoor Government Center, Bacoor Boulevard, Barangay Bayanan, Bacoor City, Cavite, represented herein by its City Mayor, **HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA**, pursuant to his authority conferred and embodied in Sangguniang Panlungsod Resolution No. _____, Series of _____, approved _____ of the City Council of Bacoor City, Cavite, hereinafter referred to as the "LGU BACOR"

-and-

The **BARANGAY MOLINO IV**, a local government unit created and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal office and postal address at **Duplex Homes Subdivision**, represented herein by its Punong Barangay **Jeffrey P. Campaña**, pursuant to his authority conferred and embodied in Barangay Resolution No. _____, Series of _____, approved _____ of the Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay *Molino IV*, Cavite, hereinafter referred to as the "BARANGAY".

"PARTY" shall mean either **LGU BACOR** or **BARANGAY**, if applicable, while the term "PARTIES" shall mean **LGU BACOR** and **BARANGAY**, collectively.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the State to provide adequate social services and an improved quality of life for all and for this purpose the State shall adopt an integrated and comprehensive approach towards health development giving priority to elderly among others.

WHEREAS, the City Government of Bacoor and Barangay **Molino IV** are mindful of the above policy of the State and are striving to provide the elderly a place for recreational, educational, health and social programs.

WHEREAS, there is a need to provide a specific area where trainings and opportunities for senior citizens in the City of Bacoor may be held;

WHEREAS, the DILG enjoined all government agencies including local government unit to formulate and implement plans and programs for senior citizens and to intensify their implementation so as to improve their living conditions and to allow them to continue to enjoy productive and comfortable lives within the society under DILG MC No. 2019-81;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, and of the mutual covenants herein contained, the **PARTIES** have **AGREED** to be bound, as follows:

1. **SCOPE.**

This Agreement shall cover the rights and responsibilities of the parties herein and Bacoor Senior Citizens and Senior Citizens Associations who would like to use the facilities of the BARANGAY as Senior Citizen Center for their activities.

2. **INTERPRETATION.**

The provisions of this AGREEMENT shall be interpreted to liberally in favour of the welfare of Bacoor Senior Citizens.

3. **STRIKE! SENIOR CITIZENS CENTER**

A STRIKE! Senior Citizens Center shall be designated in an area within the territorial jurisdiction of the BARANGAY and under the direct management and supervision of the same. It is a functional and suitable place where the Senior Citizens can come together to discuss and accomplish their social, physical, emotional and intellectual need. It is appropriate for distribution of benefits, for special events, livelihood, health, fitness and wellness enabling them to remain healthy and socially connected.

4. **VENUE/LOCATION**

The STRIKE! Senior Citizens Center in Barangay Molino IV shall be located at the Duplex Homes Barangay Hall in a vacant space fronting the office of Molino IV Senior Citizens Association, extending towards the adjoining open space.

5. **COMMON OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTIES**

- a. To provide support to the activities of senior citizens and senior citizens associations subject to the availability of funds.
- b. To provide counselling to the needs of senior citizens and senior citizens associations in the conduct of their activities and operations.
- c. To allow the interest of senior citizens and senior citizens associations in the policy making process through people's participation.

6. **OBLIGATION OF BARANGAY**

- a. To allow Senior Citizens and Senior Citizens Associations to the use of the STRIKE! Senior Citizen Center upon compliance with the Rules and Regulations as may be set forth in this MOA or as promulgated by the Office of the Mayor and that of the BARANGAY.
- b. To provide immediate assistance to Senior Citizens availing and using the STRIKE! Senior Citizens Center in case of accident or health concerns by making available first responders during their scheduled activity or events.

7. USE BY SENIOR CITIZENS AND SENIOR CITIZENS ASSOCIATIONS

- a. The use of the STRIKE! Senior Citizens Center by Senior Citizens or Senior Citizens Associations shall be only for the purpose as provided for by law, ordinance, or rules and regulations relative to the conduct of activities by Senior Citizens Associations.
- b. The BARANGAY may set forth HOUSE RULES to the application and use of Senior Citizens and Senior Citizens Associations which must not be contrary to this MOA, and the applicable laws, ordinances, or rules and regulations promulgated by the relative government agency.

8. DATA PRIVACY

Mindful of the present circumstances where the elderly are common victims of scams and fraud, the provisions of Republic Act No. 10173 or the Data Privacy Act, its implementing Rules and Regulations, and the issuances of the Data Privacy Commission shall govern and be applicable in the implementation of this AGREEMENT. The PARTIES shall ensure that the data of Senior Citizens and Senior Citizens Associations who shall utilize the STRIKE! Senior Citizens Center, be preserved and shall not be used for any purpose contrary to existing laws, ordinances, and issuances and shall not be used without the consent of the data subject-senior citizen.

9. SEVERABILITY

In case any provision of this Memorandum of Agreement shall be invalidated or declared illegal or unenforceable by an appropriate court of jurisdiction, the validity, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions shall not in any way be affected or impaired thereby and such provision shall be ineffective only to the extent of such invalidity, illegality, or unenforceability.

10. AMENDMENTS

Any amendment to this Memorandum of Agreement shall be upon the instance of the LGU Bacoor, thru the City Mayor. The Barangay, or the Senior Citizens Associations may propose written amendments hereto subject to the approval and consent of the City Mayor.

11. IN CASE OF DISAGREEMENTS

In case of disagreements between Senior Citizens or Senior Citizens or Senior Citizens Association desiring to avail of the STRIKE! Senior Citizens Center, the same shall be decided by the Punong Barangay concerned. The decision of the Punong Barangay may be appealed to the Office of the City Mayor.
