A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, TO SIGN FOUR (4) MEMORANDA OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOR AND DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION, OPERATION, AND MAINTENANCE OF SOLAR POWERED WATER STATIONS WITH FILTRATION PROJECTS AT FOUR (4) PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN THE CITY OF BACOR, CAVITE.

WHEREAS, on 22 May 2023, the Office of the City Mayor received a letter from the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) pertaining to four (4) Memoranda of Agreements relating to the operation and maintenance of solar powered water stations with filtration projects in:

1. Gov. P.F. Espiritu Elementary School
2. San Nicolas Elementary School
3. Bacoor Elementary School
4. Bacoor National High School — Molino Main.

These four (4) Memoranda of Agreements are deemed incorporated and are made an integral part of this Resolution.

WHEREAS, the DPWH is the engineering and construction arm of the national government, created under Executive Order No. 124, series of 1987. It is responsible for the planning, design, construction, and maintenance of infrastructure projects, including water resource development systems.

WHEREAS, under the Local Government Code of 1991, the Local Government Unit (LGU) is mandated to deliver basic services and facilities, including water supply. Additionally, the Code states that national agencies with project implementation functions shall coordinate with affected LGUs to discharge these functions.

WHEREAS, the project ensures the provision of clean, safe, and free drinking water to the students, contributing to their health and well-being, and subsequently promoting an environment conducive to learning.

WHEREAS, access to clean water can also reduce the incidence of waterborne diseases among school children, thereby improving overall public health and reducing absenteeism due to illness.

WHEREAS, this initiative aligns with Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991, also known as the General Welfare clause, which mandates every local government unit to promote the health and safety, maintain peace and order, enhance the prosperity and general welfare of the people.

WHEREAS, the City Government of Bacoor, in accordance with the legal mandate of the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH), recognizes the shared responsibility to promote sustainable development and improve the quality of life for all its constituents.

WHEREAS, under the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor, Hon. Strike B. Revilla, is authorized to represent the city in all its business transactions and sign on its behalf all contracts upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod.

4. The **DPWH CAVITE 3RD DISTRICT ENGINEERING OFFICE** and **LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF BACOOR** shall jointly monitor the progress and implementation of the Project, and work together to resolve any issues or concerns that may arise during its implementation; and finally.
5. Upon completion of the construction by the **DPWH CAVITE 3RD DISTRICT ENGINEERING OFFICE** and submission of the Letter of Acceptance by the **LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF BACOOR** as required by the above DPWH Guidelines, the LGU shall be responsible for the operation and maintenance of the Project, at no cost to the DPWH, unless these responsibilities are otherwise transferred to another entity, at the option of the LGU.

This MOA shall take effect upon signing by the Parties, and shall remain in force and effect until _____, unless otherwise extended in writing by both Parties.




CERTIFICATION
