A RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY RECOMMENDING TO THE CITY MAYOR TO PREVENTIVELY SUSPEND KAGAWAD EDWIN BARRANTES OF BARANGAY TALABA II AND TO ORDER THE PUNONG BARANGAY AND BARANGAY TREASURER OF THE SAID LOCAL GOVERNMENT TO CAUSE THE IMMEDIATE RELEASE OF THE FUNDS OF THE SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN OF BARANGAY TALABA II, BACOR CITY, CAVITE IN ACCORDANCE WITH LAW.

WHEREAS, on May 10, 2023, the office of the Sangguniang Panlungsod received a letter-complaint from the Chairman of the Sangguniang Kabataan of Barangay Talaba II, Hon. Juan Manjares Pante Jr. (SK Chairman Pante).

WHEREAS, the complaint alleged that Barangay Kagawad Edwin Barrantes (Kagawad Barrantes) prevented the release of Sangguniang Barangay funds of Barangay Talaba II that were meant to be released to the Sangguniang Kabataan as part of the salary of its members. The complaint further alleged that Kagawad Barrantes prevented the release of said funds by refusing or failing to sign the fund transfers in his capacity as Appropriations Officer of Barangay Talaba II. The fund transfers are for the 10% budget allocation for the Sangguniang Kabataan as provided under Section 20 of Republic Act No. 10742, as amended.

WHEREAS, the complaint further alleged that, as a result of said refusal or failure, members of the Sangguniang Kabataan were deprived of the ability to attend a seminar held in Boracay last April 2023.

WHEREAS, the complaint also alleged that in May 2023, Kagawad Barrantes again refused or failed to sign fund transfers for the Sangguniang Kabataan fund.

WHEREAS, on May 19, 2023, the Office of the Sangguniang Panlungsod received a letter from the Punong Barangay of Barangay Talaba II, Abito Enot Mahilac (PB Mahilac) wherein he alleged that the Sangguniang Barangay passed a resolution appointing Kagawad Barrantes as Budget

Appropriations Officer without his knowledge and signature contrary to the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991.

WHEREAS, PB Mahilac also corroborated SK Chairman Pante's allegation that Kagawad Barrantes either refused or failed to sign the fund transfers for the 10% budget allocation for the Sangguniang Kabataan as SK Chairman Pante showed PB Mahilac an unsigned voucher for the transfer to the SK project account of Barangay Talaba II.

WHEREAS, PB Mahilac alleged that Kagawad Barrantes has been abusing his power as barangay appropriation officer by allegedly refusing to sign the paychecks of Barangay employees and officials that he does not like. PB Mahilac alleged that Kagawad Barrantes did this to delay the salaries of a certain Mario Alfonso Agot and a certain Joreen Tadeo who have both served Barangay Talaba II for years.

WHEREAS, In Kagawad Barrantes' counter-affidavit dated June 13, 2023, he alleged that PB Mahilac could not sign the aforementioned Barangay Resolution appointing him as Barangay Appropriations Officer due to PB Mahilac's non-attendance of the session during which the resolution was passed.

WHEREAS, Kagawad Barrantes also alleged in his counter-affidavit that SK Chairman Pante was instructed by Kagawad Barrantes to fix certain documents so that he could sign the necessary forms to implement the fund transfer. However, SK Chairman Pante allegedly did not return to Kagawad Barrantes with the said documents.

WHEREAS, it was further alleged in the counter-affidavit that Joreen Tadeo was rightly not granted honorarium because they were erroneously included in the *plantilla* as a clerk even as they were serving as a Sangguniang Kabataan Secretary.

WHEREAS, it was also alleged in the counter-affidavit that Mario Alfonso Mahilac Agot is one of the nephews of Barangay Chairman Mahilac who was not appointed to any position in the SK, which is why Kagawad Barrantes did not authorize the payment of honorarium to them.

WHEREAS, on June 13, 2023, Kagawad Carlos Bombales, Kagawad Rodolfo Banas, Jr., Kagawad Imelda Badilla, Kagawad Blesilda Abarales, Kagawad Luisito Lunas, Kagawad Luisito Llesis, Kagawad Barrantes, and Secretary Janette Leonor executed a joint sworn-statement stating that, according to a certain "Mr. Wacky" from the City Accountant's Office, the signature of Kagawad Barrantes on the disbursement voucher was not necessary. Instead, the necessary signatures on said voucher were those of the Barangay Treasurer and of PB Mahilac.

WHEREAS, the said complaint was referred to the Committee on Ethics, Appointments, and Government Reorganization (the "Committee") by the Sangguniang Panlungsod Presiding Officer, Hon. Rowena Bautista-Mendiola, on May 15, 2023 during its 43rd Regular Session. Committee hearings were conducted on May 18, 2023 and June 08, 2023, with the committee members and various resource persons in attendance.

WHEREAS, on 26 June 2023, the Committee on Ethics, Appointments, and Government Reorganization issued Committee Hearing Report No. CEAGR-PCR-298-2023, which states that the discussion showed that the respondent, Kagawad Edwin Barrantes was guilty of violating Section 20 of R.A. 10742 also known as "AN ACT ESTABLISHING REFORMS IN THE SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN CREATING ENABLING MECHANISMS FOR MEANINGFUL YOUTH PARTICIPATION IN NATION-BUILDING, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES".

WHEREAS, the findings contained in the Committee Hearing Report should be adopted by this Sanggunian for several reasons to be explained in the following clauses.

WHEREAS, Section 20 of Republic Act No. 10742, as amended by Republic Act No. 11768, states that "(a) All the income of the barangay derived from whatever source shall accrue to its general fund and shall, at the option of the barangay concerned, be kept as trust fund in the custody of the city or municipal treasurer or be deposited in a bank preferably government-owned, situated in or nearest to its area of jurisdiction. Such funds shall be disbursed in accordance with the provisions of this Act. Ten percent (10%) of the general funds of the barangay shall be set aside for the Sangguniang Kabataan. The Sangguniang Kabataan funds in lump-sum which shall be disbursed for youth development and empowerment purposes..."

WHEREAS, Kagawad Barrantes' refusal to sign the fund transfers, as evidenced by his non-endorsement of the SK budget, amounts to a violation of Section 20(a) of RA 10742 which mandates that 10% of the barangay's general funds shall be set aside for the Sangguniang Kabataan.

WHEREAS, Furthermore, by not signing the fund transfer documents, Kagawad Barrantes violated Section 20(b) of RA 10742, which grants the Sangguniang Kabataan financial independence in their operations. This section states: "Sangguniang Kabataan shall have financial independence in its operations, disbursements and encashment of their fund, income and expenditures." Thus, by requiring SK Chairman Pante to present certain documents to him before he signs the voucher, the intent of RA 10742 to grant the Sangguniang Kabataan independence in the use of their fund is frustrated.

WHEREAS, this line of reasoning is further bolstered by Section 3.2 of DBM-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1 dated January 23, 2019 which provides in part that:

"3.2. Release of the SK Fund by the Barangay

3.2.1 The SK funds shall be **automatically** released by the barangay to the SK, and **shall not be subject to any lien or holdback that may be imposed by the barangay for whatever purpose.**

3.2.2 Consistent with Section 20 (b) of RA No. 10742, the SK shall open a current account in the name of the SK in a bank, preferably government-owned, situated in or nearest to its area of jurisdiction, with the SK chairperson and the SK treasurer as the official signatories. For efficiency and economy purposes, it is strongly encouraged for the SK to open and maintain a depository account in the same bank and branch of its barangay. In the opening of account, the provisions of Department of Finance Department Circular No. 1-2017 dated May 11, 2017 shall be strictly observed.

3.2.3 The SK funds **shall be deposited by the barangay in the current account of the SK not later than five (5) working days after the crediting of the monthly internal revenue allotment (IRA) share of the barangay consistent with the rules and regulations issued by the Commission on Audit (COA).**

For all other income accruing to the general fund of the barangay, the corresponding SK funds shall be deposited not later than five (5) working days after the end of the month.

The barangay may opt to transfer/release the SK funds earlier than herein prescribed on an annual, semestral or quarterly basis, subject to the written agreement between the barangay and the SK.

Failure by the barangay to release any amount of the SK fund shall subject the erring officials to penalties under existing laws. Xxx" (Emphasis supplied)

WHEREAS, Kagawad Barrantes initially refused to sign the disbursement voucher. It appears from both the letter-complaint of SK Chairman Pante and Kagawad Barrantes' counter-affidavit that SK Chairman Pante and Kagawad Barrantes had a mutual understanding at the time that Kagawad Barrantes' signature was necessary for the disbursement of the funds. By refusing to sign the voucher, he implicitly acknowledged that his signature, as the Appropriations Officer, carries a certain weight and importance in the process of releasing the funds. In other words, he posited himself as a necessary agent in the process. Contrarily, in the joint sworn statement, Kagawad Barrantes claimed that his signature was not necessary on the disbursement voucher. This is an explicit acknowledgment that he perceives his role as insignificant in the process of funds release.

WHEREAS, the previous clause indicates a logical inconsistency between the positions Kagawad Barrantes has

taken in his counter-affidavit and the joint sworn statement. Kagawad Barrantes cannot simultaneously be a necessary and an unnecessary participant in the same process. This is a contradiction, as these two positions are mutually exclusive.

WHEREAS, if Kagawad Barrantes truly believed that his signature was unnecessary, then logically, there should have been no reason for him to refuse to sign the disbursement voucher in the first place. This act of refusal denotes the exercise of a perceived power or control over the process, which contradicts his later claim of insignificance. It appears that Kagawad Barrantes has misunderstood his role as the Appropriations Officer. If he indeed believed his signature was unnecessary, he should not have refused to sign the disbursement vouchers in the first place and requested SK Chairman Pante to fix certain documents and return to him. Instead, he should have informed SK Chairman Pante that the signature of the Appropriations Officer was not required.

WHEREAS, Barangay Chairman Mahilac alleges that Kagawad Barrantes' appointment was done without his knowledge and signature, which is a direct violation of Section 54(c) of the Local Government Code of 1991. This section stipulates that all ordinances enacted by the sangguniang barangay should be signed by the punong barangay, or the Barangay Chairman, upon approval by a majority of its members.

WHEREAS, if this allegation is accurate, it presents a clear breach of the established legal process for appointments within the local government structure. This breach invalidates Kagawad Barrantes' appointment, rendering it null and void. In essence, if the mandated process was not followed, then logically, the outcome of that process (i.e., Kagawad Barrantes' appointment) cannot hold legal standing. However, this is a matter that the Sangguniang Panlungsod can not yet resolve as the Committee has not yet conducted hearings on the said matter and requires more time to do so.

WHEREAS, Kagawad Barrantes, by refusing or failing to sign the fund transfers, directly obstructs this process, causing a delay or even a potential failure in the deposit of the SK fund within the mandated timeframe in violation of the aforementioned provisions of Section 3.2 of DBM-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1 dated January 23, 2019 (the "Joint Memorandum Circular").

WHEREAS, as the Barangay Appropriation Officer, Kagawad Barrantes has a duty to ensure the proper disbursement of barangay funds, which includes the 10% of the general fund intended for the Sangguniang Kabataan, as per Republic Act No. 10742. His refusal or failure to sign the fund transfers not only contradicts his role but also violates the specific directives stated in the Joint Memorandum Circular.

WHEREAS, the Joint Memorandum Circular also mentions that "failure by the barangay to release any amount of the SK City Resolution No. 2023-288, 26 June 2023

fund shall subject the erring officials to penalties under existing laws." Kagawad Barrantes' inaction equates to a failure to release the SK fund in violation of the directives in the Joint Memorandum Circular.

WHEREAS, the SK funds of Talaba II have not been deposited to the account of the SK even after several months following the release of the National Tax Allotment for the Barangay, way beyond the 5-day period for the deposit of the funds to the account of the SK as mandated by the Joint Memorandum Circular.

WHEREAS, under Section 60 of Republic Act No. 7160 (the "Local Government Code of 1991"), an administrative complaint may be filed on the grounds of dishonesty, oppression, misconduct in office, and abuse of authority, among others.

WHEREAS, although not explicitly stated in the documents from Punong Barangay Mahilac and the allegations of SK Chairman Pante, the facts proposed in these documents imply grounds of misconduct, abuse of authority, and potential dishonesty against Kagawad Barrantes.

WHEREAS, under Section 61 of the Local Government Code of 1991, an administrative complaint against an elective barangay official shall be filed before the Sangguniang Panlungsod concerned whose decision shall be final and executory.

WHEREAS, although the documents from Barangay Chairman Mahilac and SK Chairman Pante were not explicitly labelled as "complaints," the form and allegations contained therein substantially complied with the requirements of a complaint. Moreover, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bacoor is not a court of law, and is thus not required to strictly comply with the Rules of Court, especially with respect to the Rules governing the form of pleadings and complaints.

WHEREAS, under Section 63 of the Local Government Code of 1991, a preventive suspension may be imposed by the City Mayor if the respondent is an elective official of the barangay at any time after the issues are joined, when the evidence of guilt is strong, and given the gravity of the offense, there is great probability that the continuance in office of the respondent could influence the witnesses or pose a threat to the safety and integrity of the records and other evidence: Provided, That, any single preventive suspension of local elective officials shall not extend beyond sixty (60) days: Provided, further, That in the event that several administrative cases are filed against an elective official, he cannot be preventively suspended for more than ninety (90) days within a single year on the same ground or grounds existing and known at the time of the first suspension."

WHEREAS, in the case of Kagawad Barrantes, there are strong indications of misconduct, abuse of authority, and possible violations of the Department of Budget and Management-Department of the Interior and Local Government-National Youth Commission Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1, series of 2019, as alleged by Punong Barangay Mahilac and SK Chairman Pante, which suggests a strong evidence of guilt.

WHEREAS, the gravity of the alleged offense by Kagawad Barrantes, involving the potential misallocation of the Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) fund, holds severe implications on the transparency, accountability, and overall good governance of the barangay.

WHEREAS, it is likely that the continuance in office of Kagawad Barrantes could influence potential witnesses, considering his position and authority, or pose a threat to the safety and integrity of the records and other pieces of evidence related to the allocation and use of the SK fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, upon the motion of Hon. Reynaldo D. Palabrica, and unanimously seconded by the rest of the Body, **BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**, by the 5th Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bacoor, Cavite, to recommend to the City Mayor to preventively suspend Kagawad Barrantes pending the resolution of the complaint filed against him for the alleged obstruction of fund transfers to the Sangguniang Kabataan and alleged abuse of power in his capacity as the Appropriations Officer of Barangay Talaba II.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that Punong Barangay Abito Enot Mahilac, and the Barangay Treasurer, be directed to immediately facilitate the disbursement of funds to the Sangguniang Kabataan as stipulated under Section 20 of Republic Act No. 10742, also known as the "SK Reform Act." The said funds should be disbursed without any further delay or hindrance in accordance with the law.

RESOLVED LASTLY, to furnish SK Chairman Pante, Punong Barangay Mahilac, Kagawad Barrantes, the Sangguniang Barangay of Talaba II, the Office of the City Mayor of Bacoor City, Cavite, and the University of the Philippines-Office of the National Administrative Register (UP-ONAR), and other government agencies concerned with copies of this Resolution.
