CITY RESOLUTION NO. 2023-314

Series of 2023

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISBURSEMENT OF TEN MILLION PESOS (PHP 10,000,000.00) FROM THE LOCAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT (DRRM) FUND AND AUTHORIZING THE DISBURSEMENT OF THE NECESSARY FUNDS FROM THE RESPECTIVE BARANGAY DRRM FUNDS OF THE VARIOUS BARANGAYS OF THE CITY OF BACOOR TO AUGMENT THE RELIEF OPERATIONS TO THE FAMILIES AFFECTED BY THE ENHANCED SOUTHWEST MONSOON DUE TO THE SUPER TYPHOON 'EGAY' AND OTHER RELATED EXPENSES.

WHEREAS, on July 25, 2023, the Provincial Government of Cavite, through Resolution No. 2639-2023, declared the entire province under a State of Calamity due to the significant impacts of the enhanced southwest monsoon caused by super typhoon Egay.

WHEREAS, following the aforesaid declaration, fisherfolk in the City of Bacoor, out of concern for their safety and as per advisories, were counseled against venturing into sea, impacting both their safety and their means of livelihood.

WHEREAS, approximately two thousand fisherfolk families residing in the coastal Barangays of the City of Bacoor have borne the brunt of this calamity, grappling with lost income over those days and confronting the devastation to many of their vessels, which are vital tools of their trade.

WHEREAS, in times of calamities and natural disasters, timely and efficient disaster relief operations serve as a bedrock of support, not only providing immediate succor to the affected families but also exemplifying the responsibility of a government to its constituents.

WHEREAS, the relief efforts being made to assist the affected families is ongoing, but there is a need to augment the relief efforts by injecting additional funds.

WHEREAS, hyper-local responses to disasters, with the involvement of local Barangay units, amplify the efficacy and reach of relief operations, catering specifically to the unique

of each community and ensuring that no affected individual or family is left behind.

WHEREAS, in line with these urgent relief and rebuilding efforts and to uphold the welfare of Bacooreños, there is a paramount need to disburse substantial funds from both the Local DRRM Fund of the City and from the respective Barangay DRRM Funds of the various Barangays.

WHEREAS, the mobilization of these funds is crucial to expedite and augment the relief operations, repair damaged infrastructures, and assist in the gradual recovery of the livelihoods of the affected fisherfolk families.

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 10121, Section 12 mandates the establishment of a Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (LDRRMO) in every province, city, and municipality, and a Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Committee (BDRRMC) in each barangay.

WHEREAS, the City of Bacoor, in strict observance of Section 21 of Republic Act No. 10121, has duly allocated not less than five percent (5%) of its estimated revenue from regular sources to the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (LDRRMF) of the Bacoor Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (BDRRMO).

WHEREAS, such funds ensure the capability of the City to respond effectively to emergencies, including the emergency disbursement of an additional Ten Million Pesos for the purpose of augmenting the disaster relief operations that are assisting those affected by Super typhoon 'Egay.'

NOW THEREFORE, upon motion of Hon. Reynaldo D. Palabrica and Hon. Rogelio Nolasco unanimously seconded by the rest of the Body, **BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** by the 5th Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bacoor, Cavite to authorize the City Mayor, Hon. Strike B. Revilla, to authorize the disbursement of Ten Million Pesos (PHP 10,000,000.00) from the Local DRRM Fund and to authorize the necessary disbursements from the respective Barangay DRRM Funds of the various Barangays in the City of Bacoor to support and augment the relief operations for families affected by the enhanced southwest monsoon due to the typhoon 'Egay' and other interrelated expenses.

RESOLVED LASTLY, to furnish the Bacoor Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office, the Offices of the respective Punong Barangays of the Barangays affected by typhoon 'Egay', the University of the Philippines Office of the National Administrative Register (UP-ONAR), and other government agencies concerned with copies of this Resolution.
