A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, TO SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH CABLE LINK HOLDINGS CORPORATION (CLHC) ON INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGY TO INCREASE ADMINISTRATIVE AND OPERATIONAL EFFICIENCY AND PROVIDE HIGH QUALITY GOVERNMENT SERVICE, ECONOMIC BENEFITS, AND IMPROVEMENT IN THE LIVES OF BACOOREÑOS.

WHEREAS, on 28 November 2023, the Office of the Sangguniang Panlungsod received a letter from the Office of the Mayor requesting that a resolution be passed authorizing the City Mayor to enter into and sign the proposed Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the City Government and Cable Link Holdings Corporation (CLHC) for the advancement of information and communication technology in Bacoor.

WHEREAS, the United Nations Human Rights Council resolution on "The promotion, protection and enjoyment of human rights on the Internet" (Resolution A/HRC/47/L.22) recognizes the importance of access to information and communications technology for the full enjoyment of human rights and affirms that the same rights people have offline must also be protected online, in particular freedom of expression, which aligns with the City Government's commitment to upholding these rights through improved digital infrastructure.

WHEREAS, the proposed MOA aims to fulfill the City Government's goal of expanding interconnectivity through the use of fiber optics infrastructure, which is essential for fostering a digitally inclusive society and enhancing the city's information and communications technology capabilities.

WHEREAS, the expansion of fiber optics infrastructure is crucial for Bacoor, as it promises higher data transmission speeds, greater bandwidth, and improved reliability compared to alternative internet connectivity methods, thereby significantly enhancing the quality and accessibility of internet services for residents and businesses alike.

WHEREAS, fiber optics technology, compared to alternative methods of internet connectivity, offers superior advantages in terms of speed, bandwidth, durability, and long-term cost-effectiveness.

Optical fiber uses light pulses for information transmission, delivering bandwidth hundreds of times higher than traditional electrical systems. Its thin, lightweight nature allows for greater cable density and less signal degradation, while offering a lifespan of over 100 years, ensuring the most efficient and future-proof infrastructure for Bacoor's digital needs.

WHEREAS, the signing and implementation of this MOA with CLHC align with the City Government's strategic objective to increase administrative and operational efficiency, provide high-quality government service, and support economic growth and improvement in the lives of Bacooreños, in accordance with the principles of good governance and public service.

WHEREAS, the proposed partnership with CLHC will facilitate the City Government's efforts in transforming Bacoor into a more connected and technologically advanced city, thus enhancing the overall welfare and development prospects of its residents and businesses.

WHEREAS, the City Mayor has the power to represent the City in its business transactions and sign on its behalf all contracts upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod under Republic Act No. 7160 or the Local Government Code of 1991.

NOW THEREFORE, upon motion of Hon. Rogelio Nolasco, unanimously seconded by the rest of the Body, **BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** by the 5th Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bacoor, Cavite to authorize the City Mayor, Hon. Strike B. Revilla, to sign the proposed MOA with CLHC in relation to the expansion of the City's fiber optics infrastructure.

RESOLVED LASTLY, to furnish parties to the aforementioned agreement, the University of the Philippines-Office of the National Administrative Register (UP-ONAR), and other government agencies concerned with copies of this Resolution.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Agreement (the "Agreement") is made and entered into this ____ day of _____ 2023 (the "Effective Date"), at the City of Bacoor, Cavite, by and between:

The **CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACCOOR**, a local government unit duly organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal office at Bacoor Government Center, Bacoor Boulevard, Brgy. Bayanan, Bacoor City, Cavite, represented in this Act by **HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA**, in his capacity as the City Mayor, pursuant to his authority conferred and embodied in City Resolution No. _____, and hereinafter referred to as the "**FIRST PARTY**."

and

CABLE LINK & HOLDINGS CORPORATION, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, represented in this Act by its President, **ARMANDO M. MERILLEN**O, with the principal office address at 8210 Dr. A. Santos Avenue, Parañaque City, and hereinafter referred to as the "**SECOND PARTY**."

Individually referred to as "**PARTY**" and collectively referred to as the "**PARTIES**".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the **FIRST PARTY** envisioned transforming Bacoor City into a Smart City that utilizes information and communication technology (ICT) to increase administrative and operational efficiency and provide a high quality of government services, economic benefits, and improvements in the lives of citizens;

WHEREAS, the **SECOND PARTY** is a holder of a congressional franchise and is thus empowered and authorized to construct, install, establish, operate, and maintain for commercial purposes and in the public interest cable television (CATV) systems, Broadband Internet, and other related services throughout the Philippines by virtue of Republic Act No. 9382 and Certificate of Authority from the National Telecommunications Commission;

WHEREAS, the **SECOND PARTY** recognizes that fiber technology is the critical ingredient in building a smart city, optimizing interconnected technologies for effective and efficient communication, analysis, and transfer of information;

WHEREAS, earlier on, a **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)** notarized on January 25, 2017, was entered into between the **FIRST PARTY** and the **SECOND PARTY** for the free and beneficial use of its available fiber optics cable to support and interconnect the **FIRST PARTY** CCTV cameras installed in key locations within the City of Bacoor to the Command, Control, and Coordinating Center located in Bacoor Government Center, Bacoor Boulevard, Brgy. Bayanan, Bacoor City, Cavite ;

WHEREAS, the **SECOND PARTY** is willing to expand its fiber optics infrastructure in the City of Bacoor to deliver numerous public and commercial services through robust and stable connectivity, thereby enhancing the economy's efficiency and competitiveness;

WHEREAS, the **PARTIES** recognize the value of fostering cooperation and collaboration to create a joined-up technologically enabled, sustainable, and mutually beneficial infrastructure;

WHEREAS, the **SECOND PARTY** is willing to extend the free and beneficial use of its fiber infrastructure that will enable the **FIRST PARTY** to create a connected digital ecosystem;

WHEREAS, the **PARTIES** are now desirous of executing this document, amending specific terms of the aforementioned MOU in accordance with the terms and conditions contained herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the following terms and conditions, the **FIRST PARTY**, as part of its governmental function, and the **SECOND PARTY**, in its corporate capacity, hereby freely and mutually agree that:

I. SCOPE OF SERVICE:

1. The **SECOND PARTY** shall establish a robust fiber optics backbone infrastructure and access network adapting to the emerging technologies and consumer demand complexities with Fiber-to-the-X via Gigabit PON network as its deployment of choice. However, the **SECOND PARTY** may adapt to all other related technologies at present available or to be made available through technological advances or innovations in the future, as is, or as are convenient to or essential to deliver its services efficiently.
2. The **SECOND PARTY** shall install or erect twenty-five (25) feet, 7A class centrifugal pre-pressed concrete poles along primary and secondary roads for the fiber optics cable attachment necessary to implement its fiber network program.
3. The **SECOND PARTY**, aside from the Fiber-to-the-Home (FTTH) distribution system, shall establish Fiber-to-the-Antenna (FTTA) for its commercial Internet Hotspot access services to support the **FIRST PARTY** Public WiFi projects.
4. In its network planning and design, the **SECOND PARTY** shall consider the **FIRST PARTY**'s connectivity plan, linking its physical assets with technology-based resources, systems, and applications, as mutually agreed.

II. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE FIRST PARTY

1. The **FIRST PARTY** recognizes and supports the right of the **SECOND PARTY** to construct, erect poles, establish its overhead or underground fiber optic cable facilities, and install a radio or fixed network appliances, including but not limited to WiFi antennas, access points, and other devices, to deliver, and maintain its services within the City while its Congressional Franchise is subsisting and with force and effect as provided for under Republic Act No. 9382.
2. The **FIRST PARTY** shall assist the **SECOND PARTY** in processing and securing the necessary easement and right-of-way permit/s to erect concrete poles, guy anchorage to attach essential and overhead cable lines, and appurtenance thereto.
3. The **FIRST PARTY** shall provide the **SECOND PARTY**, after a written request is made, with access and permission to use available public space to set up appropriate network appliances and devices to support the establishment and

the operations of an interconnected network, equally advantageous to the **SECOND PARTY** and the **FIRST PARTY**'s beneficiaries and instrumentalities.

4. The **FIRST PARTY** shall provide the necessary assistance to the **SECOND PARTY** after a written request is made to ensure continuous and unhampered work, including but not limited to access facilitation with the Barangays, Subdivisions, Villages, and Urban Communities, if necessary.
5. All electronic devices, network appliances, or equipment to be installed by the **FIRST PARTY** to **SECOND PARTY**'s poles and fiber optics facilities, as well as software, key applications, or developed systems necessary for establishing the **FIRST PARTY**'s digital ecosystem, shall be for the account of the **FIRST PARTY**.
6. The **FIRST PARTY**, as an accommodation to the **SECOND PARTY** for allowing it to use its Fiber Optic Infrastructure and poles, shall exempt the **SECOND PARTY** from payment of Real Property Taxes relative to all the utility poles to be erected in the City of Bacoor during the effectivity of this Agreement.
7. The **FIRST PARTY** may procure/buy/subscribe to additional internet access/bandwidth requirements, managed services, including connectivity, and other ICT solutions, from the **SECOND PARTY** at a preferential price in case the **FIRST PARTY** deems it necessary.

III. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE SECOND PARTY

1. The **SECOND PARTY** recognizes and supports the Smart City vision of the **FIRST PARTY** to create and promote urban development, economic competitiveness, and citizen welfare through a technologically enabled and sustainable infrastructure.
2. The **SECOND PARTY** shall provide the **FIRST PARTY** with a maximum of two (2) dark fiber cores as its fiber connectivity foundation **FREE OF CHARGE** to deliver connected solutions to the City of Bacoor, thus providing private and public sectors efficiencies, economic benefits, and improved lives of its citizens.
3. The **SECOND PARTY** shall allow the **FIRST PARTY** to attach or install any of its electronic devices, network appliances, and fixtures to the **SECOND PARTY**'s erected poles, such as but not limited to CCTV cameras, smart street lights, alarm, and monitoring systems and public announcement devices, in consideration of the standards and guidelines set as provided for in Annex "A": Joint Pole Use.
4. The **SECOND PARTY** shall provide the **FIRST PARTY**, through the Office of the Building Official, with duly accomplished plans, pertinent vicinity maps, and drawings exhibiting pole locations and attachments, including support guys, wire, equipment, devices, and other accessories to secure assistance in obtaining any right-of-way or privilege or easement in the Public Highway/Property or the Private Property of third **PARTIES**.
5. The **SECOND PARTY** commits to providing an additional daily One-Hour Internet Access Service per user, with a collective speed of 100 MBPS allocated to each Cable Link Community Hotspot location. This supplementary service is specifically designed to bolster the **FIRST PARTY**'s Free Public WiFi project. It is essential to emphasize that this provision should not be misinterpreted as a free service for the **FIRST PARTY**'s Free Public WiFi

project. Users may access the service by paying the applicable fees associated with the **SECOND PARTY's** Internet Access Service.

6. The **SECOND PARTY** shall provide the **FIRST PARTY** with needed support, system integration, and expertise through its network of technology and solution partners.
7. All infrastructure, including the concrete poles, overhead and underground cable lines, equipment, and appurtenance provided and installed by the **SECOND PARTY** shall remain its property and be in charge of the maintenance of fiber optic facilities.
8. The **SECOND PARTY** shall provide the necessary orientation, technology update, and knowledge transfer to the **FIRST PARTY's** key personnel related to the simple upkeep of its fiber optic infrastructure and connected network as part of an initial assessment to identify and isolate network problem/s that may hamper the operation of the **FIRST PARTY's** interconnected network. Operation and maintenance of the fiber infrastructure shall remain the responsibility of the **SECOND PARTY**.
9. The **SECOND PARTY** shall serve key locations identified by the **FIRST PARTY** and serviceable by the **SECOND PARTY's** fiber optics infrastructure. After the **FIRST PARTY's** identification of its key locations to the **SECOND PARTY**, the **SECOND PARTY** is given the period of six (6) months to complete the construction and installation of fiber optics infrastructure as required by the **SECOND PARTY** under this Agreement, subject to the approval of Right-of-Way (ROW); Pole Attachment (RTA) and/or Pole erection permits.

IV. EFFECTIVITY AND TERMINATION

This Memorandum of Agreement shall take effect immediately upon execution. It will continue while the Congressional Franchise of the **SECOND PARTY** subsists with force and effect as provided under Republic Act 9382 and Certificate of Authority from the National Telecommunications Commission and other government-issued permits and licenses. And for as long as the **FIRST PARTY** commissions the continuous free and beneficial use of the **SECOND PARTY's** Fiber and other outside plant facilities.

Pursuant to the provision of this Agreement, should either Party cause the termination of this facility engagement, the **SECOND PARTY** shall continue with the operations and maintenance of its facilities as mandated by law. The receiving party must fully acknowledge the receipt of a written notice of termination from the requisitioning party within sixty (60) days prior to the effectivity date of termination.

The **FIRST PARTY** shall remove all its equipment connected or attached to the **SECOND PARTY's** fiber facilities within thirty (30) days after receiving the written notice of termination.

If the termination of this facility agreement is caused by the **SECOND PARTY**, all discounts, exemptions, and other privileges granted by the **FIRST PARTY** under this agreement or any other previous agreement, if any, shall be terminated upon receipt of the written notice. In addition, if the **SECOND PARTY** terminates this facility agreement without justifiable cause, the **SECOND PARTY** shall be liable to pay the **FIRST PARTY**, within thirty (30) days upon receipt of the written notice of termination, an amount of FIFTY THOUSAND PESOS (PHP 50,000.00) as a penalty.

V. CONFIDENTIALITY, NON-DISCLOSURE, AND USE OF INFORMATION.

The **PARTIES** agree that it will not at any time disclose to any person or use any Confidential Information or permit any person to examine or make copies of any documents which contain or are derived from Confidential Information, whether prepared by either party or otherwise coming into its possession or control without the prior written permission from the other, during the term of this Agreement and two (2) years after its termination. The **PARTIES** assured that all information would be treated with utmost confidentiality following the strict guidelines of Republic Act 10173 (Data Privacy Act of 2012).

VI. RELATIONSHIP OF THE PARTIES.

Nothing in this Agreement is intended to constitute a partnership or joint venture between the **PARTIES** or create an agency relationship. Neither of the **PARTIES** shall hold itself as a partner, joint-venture partner, or agent of the other under this Agreement.

VII. BINDING EFFECT.

Each provision contained in this Agreement shall inure to the benefit of and shall be binding upon the officers, directors, agents, assigns, personal representatives, the like, and all other successors-in-interest of the **PARTIES**.

VIII. ENTIRE AGREEMENT.

This Agreement sets forth the entire understanding and agreement between the **PARTIES** pertaining to the subject matter hereof. It supersedes all prior understanding, negotiations, and discussions, whether oral or written, of the **PARTIES** inconsistent with this Agreement.

There are no warranties, representations, or other Agreements between the **PARTIES** in connection with the subject matter hereof except as expressly set forth herein. Any inconsistency between the provisions of this Agreement and other agreements or contracts, the provisions of this Agreement shall prevail.

IX. AMENDMENTS, MODIFICATIONS, ADDITIONS, DELETIONS.

This Agreement or part hereof may be modified, repealed, altered, extended, revised, amended, or supplemented by mutual written agreement subscribed by the representatives of both **PARTIES**.

X. WAIVER.

A waiver of any portion of this Agreement shall not be deemed a waiver or renunciation of its other parts, which shall remain valid and enforceable.

XI. SEPARABILITY.

In case any provision of this Agreement is adjudged unlawful or unconstitutional by a final judgment of a competent court, the other provisions shall remain valid and effective.

XII. APPLICABLE LAW AND VENUE OF SUITS.

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Philippines. Any action or proceeding arising from or in connection with this Agreement shall exclusively be brought before a court of competent jurisdiction in Bacoor City, Cavite, Philippines, to the exclusion of all other venues.

Annex "A" *Standards and Guidelines on the Joint Pole Use:*

1. The **FIRST PARTY**'s attachment must be made only within the space allotted by the **SECOND PARTY** and in such manner as not to deprive or affect the use of the **SECOND PARTY** of its poles.
2. The intended use of the pole shall be subject to separate and individual consideration, with each attachment compliant with the best engineering practice.
3. Whenever the **FIRST PARTY** intends to establish an attachment, the **SECOND PARTY** must be notified in writing and, with all relevant factors considered, issue its approval in writing.
4. The **FIRST PARTY** shall provide the **SECOND PARTY** with an as-built report for each attachment as a reference for the maintenance and upkeep of the pole. The **FIRST PARTY** shall also notify in writing the **SECOND PARTY** should there be plans to remove any of its attachments. The **SECOND PARTY** shall assist the **FIRST PARTY**, if necessary, to ensure the installation or removal of any attachment will not affect or compromise its facilities and the integrity of its pole.
5. Both **PARTIES** shall adhere to the standards set forth by all applicable national and city regulations on the use of poles.
 - a. Sufficient guying and grounding shall be installed by respective **PARTIES** whenever required by any of their attachment to prevent the pole from leaning or falling, and each **PARTY** shall provide its anchor ties to support its attachment.
 - b. Any damage to the **PARTIES'** facilities, including damage to public or private properties sustained during the installation, corrective, replacement, or removal works, shall be for the sole account of the Party conducting the said work.
6. Both **PARTIES** should observe proper clearances and spacing between attachments to allow easy access for maintenance and other relevant works.
7. Whenever it is necessary for the **SECOND PARTY** to replace, relocate or retire the pole, the **FIRST PARTY** shall be notified in writing and given at least two (2) weeks to remove or transfer its attachment at its own expense. Failure of the **FIRST PARTY** to remove its attachment within the prescribed period means an automatic approval for the **SECOND PARTY** to remove the **FIRST PARTY**'s attachment in the best and safest manner available. However, the **SECOND PARTY** shall not be responsible for any damage resulting from such removal. Further, all costs incurred in the removal of said attachment shall be at the expense of the **FIRST PARTY**. The **FIRST PARTY** shall hold the **SECOND PARTY** free and harmless from any and all liability arising from the removal.
8. In the absence of negligence, bad faith or willful misconduct, a **PARTY** shall not be held liable by the other **PARTY** or by any other person, including any party claiming by, through or on behalf of a third party, for any damages and/or death of or injuries to the employees of the respective **PARTIES** or for damages to the property of either **PARTY**, or injuries to other persons or their property, arising out of the joint use of poles under this Agreement, or due to the proximity of the wires and fixtures of the **PARTIES** attached to the jointly used poles covered by this Agreement.
9. While the **SECOND PARTY** is responsible for the maintenance of the poles and the fiber cable lines, each **PARTY** shall maintain its respective attachments, supports, fixtures, appliances, or equipment.
