WHEREAS, on 04 April 2024, the Office of the City Mayor requested the Sangguniang Panlungsod to pass a resolution ratifying and confirming the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) executed by the City Government of Bacoor, the Department of Education City Schools Division of Bacoor (DepEd Bacoor), the Liga Ng Mga Barangay (LNB) Bacoor, the Sangguniang Kabataan Federation-Bacoor City (SK-Fed Bacoor) and by the Bacoor City Organization of Private Schools (BCOPS).

WHEREAS, the City Government of Bacoor together with DepEd Bacoor, LNB Bacoor, SK Fed Bacoor and BCOPS agreed to implement the Youth Programs and Activities in identified barangays in the City of Bacoor.

WHEREAS, on 26 March 2024, City Mayor, Hon. Strike B. Revilla, signed a Memorandum of Understanding on behalf of the City Government of Bacoor with the DepEd Bacoor, LNB Bacoor, SK Fed Bacoor and BCOPS.

The term "PARTY" shall mean LGU BACCOOR, DEPED BACCOOR, LNB BACCOOR, SK FED BACCOOR, or BCOPS, if applicable, while the term "PARTIES" shall mean LGU BACCOOR, DEPED BACCOOR, LNB BACCOOR, SK FED BACCOOR and BCOPS, collectively.

WITNESSETH:


WHEREAS, the LGU BACCOOR was converted into a City on 10 April 2012 pursuant to Republic Act No. 10160, otherwise known as the Charter of the City of Bacoor;


WHEREAS, under Section 16 Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code, [e]very local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants;


WHEREAS, under Section 17(a) of the said Code, [l]ocal government units shall likewise exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective provisions of the basic services and facilities;


WHEREAS, under Section 17(b) of the same Code, such basic services and facilities include, but are not limited to, the [s]ocial welfare services which include programs and projects on child and youth welfare, family and community welfare, women's welfare, welfare of the elderly and disabled persons; community-based rehabilitation programs for vagrants, beggars, street children, scavengers, juvenile delinquents, and victims of drug abuse; livelihood and other pro-poor projects; nutrition services; and family planning services;



certain basic services, capability-building and livelihood projects and to develop local enterprises designed to improve productivity and income, diversity agriculture, spur rural industrialization, promote ecological balance, and enhance the economic and social well-being of the people;

WHEREAS, the Department of Education is the Department of Education, City Schools Division Office of Bacoor ("DEPED BACCOOR") is under the jurisdiction of the Department of Education of the Philippines, the primary government instrumentality mandated to formulate, implement, and coordinate policies, plans, programs, and projects in the areas of formal and non-formal basic education;

WHEREAS, the Bacoor City Organization of Private Schools ("BCOPS") is a private organization that works for the benefit and furtherance of the education and learning of all students attending the private schools within the City of Bacoor;

WHEREAS, the leadership of the **LNB BACCOOR, SK FED BACCOOR, DEPED BACCOOR, BCOPS,** and **LGU BACCOOR** has agreed to work hand-in-hand by strengthening its partnership on youth programs and activities through this MOU to ensure the proper coordination, collective efforts, safety in health and security, and widest information dissemination of programs and activities geared towards the betterment of the youth in the City of Bacoor;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the premises and covenants hereinafter stated, the Parties hereto agree as follows:


I. SCOPE OF PARTICIPATION


1. All programs and activities geared towards the enrichment of the knowledge, skills, and experience of the student learners enrolled in both private and public schools within the jurisdiction of the City of Bacoor;
2. Strengthening of the Adopt-A-School Program of the LGU;
3. Establishment of a Federation of Private School Student Government; and
4. Other programs and activities that may be agreed upon after the signing of the MOU.


II. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES


A. DEPED BACCOOR.


1. **DEPED BACCOOR** may inform the **LGU BACCOOR, LNB BACCOOR,** and **SK FED BACCOOR** of all its youth programs and activities; and
2. After the required coordination with the **LGU BACCOOR, LNB BACCOOR,** and **SK FED BACCOOR,** the **PARTIES** shall work together in unity to implement the Programs and Activities for the benefit of the student learners enrolled in both private and public schools within the jurisdiction of the City of Bacoor.



E. LGU BACCOOR.


1. **LGU BACCOOR** shall extend the necessary assistance to DEPED BACCOOR and BCOPS in the implementation of its youth programs and activities in identified Barangays in the City of Bacoor in order to achieve the purpose of this MOU;
2. **LGU BACCOOR** may, depending on the availability of funds, provide funding or assist in sponsorships for the recommended youth programs and activities of DEPED BACCOOR, BCOPS, LNB BACCOOR, and SK FED BACCOOR;
3. The **LGU BACCOOR** may recommend or include as part of its City's Projects, youth programs and activities, such as *Peacebuilding & Security, and Social Inclusion and Equity*, among others that will promote the enrichment of the knowledge, skills and experience of the City's youth.
4. **LGU BACCOOR**, through its City Information Office (CIO), shall:
 - a. Promote the Youth Programs and Activities implemented in partnership with the LGU BACCOOR;
 - b. Assist in creating promotional and educational materials containing the announcement and other promotion for the successful implementation of the Youth Programs and Projects sponsored by the LGU BACCOOR as mentioned in the preceding paragraph.


III. INDIVIDUAL AND SEPARATE GUIDELINES. Every partnership between or among any of the Parties herein shall be subject to individual and separate Implementing Guidelines, fit-for-purpose, in order to ensure that the Youth Programs and Activities of either the DEPED BACCOOR, BCOPS, FPTA BACCOOR, FOUNDATION, LNB BACCOOR and/or SK FED BACCOOR are well-coordinated and will be duly implemented based on the pertinent national and local laws, rules and regulations.


IV. EFFECTIVITY. Unless otherwise terminated as provided herein, this MOU shall commence to take effect on the Effective Date abovementioned and shall remain effective unless sooner terminated by any of the Parties herein. Any of the Parties may terminate this MOU based only on valid and equitable grounds by written notice to the other Parties at least thirty (30) days prior to the intended date of termination.


V. AMENDMENT. This MOU may be amended if any of the Parties deem it fit in order to create and strengthen the partnership and






