A RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE, THROUGH CHIEF ROMMEL FRANCISCO MARBIL, FOR A SPECIAL RECRUITMENT QUOTA FOR THE BACOOR CITY COMPONENT POLICE STATION.

WHEREAS, the City Government is mandated by law to maintain peace and order and promote the general welfare within the City of Bacoor, Cavite.

WHEREAS, Section 27 of Republic Act No. 6975 (the "Department of Interior and Local Government Act of 1990") provides that the minimum police-to-population ratio shall not be less than one (1) policeman for every one thousand (1,000) persons: Provided, further, That urban areas shall have a higher minimum police-to-population ratio as may be prescribed by regulations.

WHEREAS, Memorandum Circular No. 98-01, the police-to-population ration of the Philippine National Police should one (1) police officer for 1,000 inhabitants or a police-to-population ratio of 1:500.

WHEREAS, as of April 2024, the City of Bacoor, Cavite has a population of 664,625 inhabitants and its police-to-population is 1:3,425 which means that it needs 1,400 police officers in order to meet the minimum PNP manning requirement mentioned above.

WHEREAS, the Bacoor City Component Police Station has 7 police commissioned officers (PCOs), 187 police non-commissioned officers (PNCOs), and 5 non-uniformed personnel (NUP) or a total workforce of 194 police personnel.

WHEREAS, the City of Bacoor continues to grow at an astonishing rate in terms of its revenue generating capacity as well as its population. These twin factors are a boon and a bane because even as they help the City become more progressive,
