**CITY RESOLUTION NO. 2024-555**  
**Series of 2024**

**A RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THE SISTER LOCAL GOVERNMENTS OF THE CITY OF BACOR, CAVITE FOR ASSISTANCE IN OBTAINING COCONUT HUSKS, ONION NETS AND/OR HUMAN HAIR TO BE USED TO IN CONSTRUCTING IMPROVISED OIL SPILL BOOMS TO PREVENT THE SPREAD INTO BACOR BAY OF THE OIL SPILLED BY M/T TERRA NOVA AFTER IT CAPSIZED IN THE COASTAL WATERS OF BATAAN ON 25 JULY 2024.**

**WHEREAS**, during the height of the onslaught of Typhoon Carina which was made worse by the effect of the southwest monsoon over the Province of Cavite and other areas in Southern Luzon on 25 July 2024, three sea vessels sank in the coastal waters of the Province of Bataan. Among the said vessels was M/T Terra Nova which had a cargo of 1.4 million liters of industrial oil.

**WHEREAS**, due to the sinking of the M/T Terra Nova, a still undetermined amount of industrial oil and fuel spilled on the sea and has since spread to various parts of Bataan and Cavite.

**WHEREAS**, the environmental and public health emergency created by the capsizing of the said vessel has gotten so serious that on July 31, 2024, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Cavite declared a state of calamity over the coastal areas of the Cities of Bacoor and Cavite and the Municipalities of Kawit, Rosario, Noveleta, Tanza, Naic, and Maragondon.

**WHEREAS**, in the afternoon of July 31, 2024, the local government of the City of Bacoor, Cavite went into emergency mode and marshaled all of its personnel and resources to mitigate the impact of the said oil spill through the construction and installation of kilometers long, improvised oil spill booms made from various recycled materials donated by Bacooreños from all walks of life who answered the call for help from the City Government.

The said improvised oil spill booms were deployed to various parts of Bacoor Bay to prevent the oil slick from entering the municipal waters of the City, protect the livelihood of the approximately 4,000 fisherfolks of the City of Bacoor, and to protect the 32-hectare mangrove swamp that the local government has been cultivating since 2007.

**WHEREAS**, huge quantities of used plastic bottles (of all colors and sizes), human hair collected from local hair salons and barber shops, coconut husks, and onion nets donated by the public were used by the personnel of the Office of Agricultural Services and the City Environmental Services Department of the City Government in constructing the improvised oil spill booms mentioned above. The OAS and CESD reported that, due in part to the efforts of the City Government and the public, no visible traces of the oil spill has been observed within the municipal waters of the City of Bacoor as of 5 August 2024. Despite this achievement, the threat of petrochemical contamination of the marine resources of the City continues and the task of constructing and installing more improvised oil spill booms must persist. However, the OAS and the CESD are now running out of supplies of coconut husks and onion nets which are instrumental in absorbing petrochemicals floating in the water and the City Government is now in need of the assistance of other local governments so it can continue in effectively dealing with the oil spill.

**WHEREAS**, Section 35 of Republic Act No. 7160 (the "Local Government Code of 1991") provides that "local government units may, through appropriate ordinances, group themselves, consolidate, or coordinate their efforts, services, and resources for purposes commonly beneficial to them. In support of such undertakings, the local government units involved may, upon approval by the sanggunian concerned after a public hearing conducted for the purpose, contribute funds, real estate, equipment, and other kinds of property and appoint or assign personnel under such terms and conditions as may be agreed upon by the participating local units through Memoranda of Agreement."

**WHEREAS**, all local governments are empowered by Section 16 of RA 7160 to exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare and to undertake measures within their respective jurisdictions that will enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology.
