A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, TO SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH 1LIFE INCORPORATED ON BEHALF OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOR TO CONDUCT A SERIES OF MEDICAL MISSIONS FOR LOCAL RESIDENTS.

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2024, the Office of the City Mayor formally requested the Sangguniang Panlungsod to pass a resolution authorizing the Hon. Strike B. Revilla to sign and enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with 1Life Incorporated on behalf of the City Government of Bacoor to conduct a series of medical missions for the benefit of city residents.

WHEREAS, a perusal of the said Memorandum of Agreement show that 1Life is a service provider duly accredited by the Department of Health (DOH), specializing in accessible and efficient diagnostics and health data management through its innovative technology.

WHEREAS, under the said Memorandum, 1Life shall provide a field hospital system encompassing the provision of medical equipment, staffing and management of medical records. This includes the following services:

- a. Provision of consultations with medical practitioners.
- b. Use of mobile diagnostic laboratories, medical devices, and technology that is able to provide same-day diagnostic results.
- c. Collection and management of patient's medical records.
- d. Provision of medicines and vitamins.

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod deliberated on the said request and found it beneficial to the residents of Bacoor.

WHEREAS, a copy of a draft Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) was sent to the Sangguniang Panlungsod by the Office of the City Mayor for its review and consideration. The proposed MOA is incorporated hereto and will be made an integral part of this Resolution.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Agreement is made and entered into by and between:

The **CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACCOOR**, a local government unit created and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal office address at Bacoor Government Center, Bacoor Boulevard, Barangay Bayanan, Bacoor City, Province of Cavite, represented herein by its City Mayor, **HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA**, pursuant to his authority conferred and embodied in City Resolution No. _____, and hereinafter referred to as the "**CITY**";

and

The **1LIFE INCORPORATED**, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal business address at 71 Simoun St. Brgy. Santo Domingo, District 1, Quezon City, represented herein by its Vice President for Corporate Sales, **MR. JOHN ROSS FRANCISCO**, hereinafter referred to as "**1LIFE**".

"PARTY" shall mean either the CITY or 1LIFE, if applicable, while the term "PARTIES" shall mean CITY and 1LIFE, collectively.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the City Mayor is mandated to ensure the delivery of basic services and provision of adequate facilities, including health services and facilities to meet the needs of the community;

WHEREAS, numerous indigent and low-income residents of the City of Bacoor are not capable of accessing timely and affordable medical assistance, including diagnostics that are costly and time-consuming in character;

WHEREAS, 1Life is a service provider duly accredited by the DOH, specializing in accessible and efficient diagnostics and health data management through its innovative technology;

WHEREAS, 1Life offers comprehensive healthcare services to the indigent residents of the City of Bacoor through performing patient consultations, essential diagnostic tests, supplying medicines and vitamins, and managing patient information capable of connecting to a wider network of healthcare providers, professionals, and pharmacies;

WHEREAS, 1Life expressed willingness to provide its medical equipment, dedicated personnel, and expertise needed to aid the City Government of Bacoor in its mission to provide accessible healthcare services to its indigent residents;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Bacoor recognizes the need to enhance the delivery of public health services and, thus, resolves to enter into partnership with medical service providers equipped with advanced technology, proficient personnel, and a shared commitment to this worthy cause;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises and the mutual covenants contained herein, the PARTIES agreed as follows:

I. OBJECTIVES.

The City Government of Bacoor and 1Life collaboratively undertake to conduct a series of medical missions for the constituents of the City of Bacoor. This partnership aims to bring healthcare services closer to the people through medical missions aimed at providing early detection and prevention of common healthcare diseases, consequently saving people's lives and reducing public health expenditures.

II. SCOPE OF SERVICES.

As the partner service provider, 1Life shall provide a field hospital system encompassing the provision of medical equipment, staffing, and management of medical records. This includes the following services: (a) provision of consultations with medical practitioners, (b) use of mobile diagnostic laboratories, medical devices, and technology that is able to provide same-day diagnostic results, (c) collection and management of patient's medical records, and (d) provision of medicines and vitamins. In relation to the management of patient records, 1Life will use its Cloud system to store and share medical data that can be accessed remotely by medical professionals. The healthcare service package that will be provided by 1Life is outlined in Annex "A" attached hereto and made an integral part hereof.

III. TERM.

This Agreement shall commence on the day of its execution and shall continue until December 31, 2024, unless terminated earlier as provided herein.

There shall be two sessions of medical mission held in the City of Bacoor every month, with each session accommodating up to 300 patients to avail themselves of healthcare services.

IV. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES.

A. The CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACCOOR shall:

1. Provide a suitable location/venue for setting up a field hospital capable of accommodating 300 patients per medical mission. Ensure that the venue is easily accessible and has unobstructed traffic flow for emergencies.
2. Ensure that the venue is compliant with all relevant health and safety regulations.
3. Ensure the availability of necessary infrastructure, including electricity, water supply, comfort rooms, waste disposal chairs, tables, water dispensers, and proper ventilation, for each medical mission. Assign maintenance personnel readily available to assist with any repairs and maintenance required for the venue.
4. Allocate an additional room suitable for X-Ray services whenever possible.
5. Provide assistance to the 1Life team during the entire medical mission, including logistical support, coordination, and other necessary assistance for the smooth conduct of each medical mission.

6. Allow the 1Life team to conduct site/venue inspection before the actual medical mission day.
7. Maintain peace and order at the medical mission venue and ensure the public safety of the medical mission team. Coordinate with law enforcement agencies such as PNP and BFP to ensure the successful implementation of the activities.
8. Provide support staff and personnel to ensure smooth operations of the field hospital, including pre-registration and adherence to patient care protocols.
9. Assign a dedicated coordinator or core management team, composed of personnel from the City Social Welfare and Development Office, Office of the City Health Services, and other concerned offices of the CITY, that will closely coordinate with 1Life for the preparation, implementation, and post-evaluation of all medical missions that will be conducted under this agreement.
10. Initiate pre-registration of patients to ensure constituents from all barangays have the opportunity to avail themselves of medical mission services, and conduct an initial assessment on the patients and preparation of case study.
11. Maintain pertinent records and documentation of all medical missions to meet accounting requirements effectively.
12. Oversee the overall implementation of this Agreement.

B. The 1LIFE INCORPORATED shall:

1. Render basic health care services during the medical mission, including but not limited to medical consultations, diagnostic tests, medications, and other medical interventions, as needed by the patients.
2. Collect relevant data during the medical mission to facilitate patient care. Data privacy and confidentiality shall be strictly observed.
3. Provide data privacy notice and secure patient's consent prior to uploading his/her personal information and medical records to the 1Life Cloud system;
4. Ensure that the field hospital system is compliant with all relevant health and safety regulations.
5. Deploy a sufficient number of personnel in its medical team, including specialized staff (radiologist/radiologic technologist, medical technologist, ultrasound technologist, IT staff) for the X-ray, CBC, Ultrasound, and ID Printing services.
6. Organize transportation, food, and accommodation for its medical team throughout the duration of the medical missions.
7. Dispense appropriate medicines/vitamins, up to a maximum of 30 tablets, depending on the diagnosis, needs, and availability of the patient. Provide a list of all medicines and vitamins that will be provided during the medical mission, including the corresponding brand and labeling. Proper documentation and labeling of medicines shall be ensured.
8. Submit a comprehensive report of each completed medical mission operation within five (5) days from the conclusion thereof. The report should include a list of patients attended to, along with the corresponding services rendered to each, copies of medical prescriptions issued to the patient, and details of medicines/vitamins dispensed to each patient.
9. Offer recommendations for improving the conduct of medical missions under this agreement.
10. Ensure that data on patients' demographics has been shared/furnished to the CITY through the Office of the City Health Services for future planning purposes.

V. DATA SHARING.

Both parties agree to share relevant data necessary for the successful conduct of the medical mission, including but not limited to patient information, demographic information, and relevant health history. The parties likewise agree to utilize cloud-based platforms for the storage and sharing of data related to field hospital services. 1LIFE shall ensure compliance with all relevant data protection regulations and industry standards regarding the storage and transmission of data.

All data collected during the medical mission shall be handled in compliance with applicable laws and regulations governing data privacy and protection, including but not limited to accordance with the pertinent provisions of the Data Privacy Act of 2012 (Republic Act No. 10173). The data privacy rights of the patient shall be protected at all times, and Parties shall ensure the confidentiality and security of such data.

Access to the shared data shall be limited to each Party's authorized personnel, who require such access solely for the purpose of conducting medical missions, monitoring public health information, and providing references for future planning on the public health sector in the City of Bacoor.

Parties agree not to use the shared data for any commercial purposes or disclose it to any third parties without prior written consent from the City Government.

The parties shall retain the shared data only for the duration necessary to fulfill the purposes outlined in this agreement. Upon completion of the medical missions or termination of this agreement, whichever occurs earlier, both parties shall promptly and securely dispose of all shared data in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.

VI. CONFIDENTIALITY.

All information obtained during the medical mission, regardless of how it was obtained and the nature of the information, during this Agreement shall be kept confidential. The Parties agree to take necessary measures to safeguard such information and shall not, without prior consent, disclose, reproduce, or use confidential information for any purpose other than achieving the objectives of the medical mission and promotion of public health. This confidentiality shall succeed even after the termination of this Agreement.

VII. MISCELLANEOUS.

1. **TERMINATION.** The Parties shall have the right to pre-terminate this Agreement by serving a written notice to the other party at least thirty (30) days prior to the intended date of termination and based on the following grounds:
 - a. Upon mutual agreement of the Parties
 - b. There is any material violation of the foregoing covenants that will warrant the cancellation of this Agreement. Provided that the terminating party shall formally inform the other of the grievance before any decision to terminate is made and finalized.
2. **AUTHORITY.** Each Party represents and warrants on its own behalf that the individual signing this Agreement is fully authorized to sign on behalf of and bind it and that it has the power and authority to enter into it.

3. **GOOD FAITH.** In complying with and implementing the terms of this Agreement, the Parties shall exercise good faith and cooperation to fulfill their common objective.
4. **RELATIONSHIP OF PARTIES.** The Parties' relationship under and in relation to this Agreement shall be limited to the matters contained herein. Nothing herein provided shall be considered or interpreted as constituting the relationship of the Parties or any of them as a partnership in which any one or more of the Parties may be liable for the acts or omissions of any other Party or Parties, nor shall anything herein contained be considered or interpreted as constituting any Party as the general agent of the other Party.
5. **AMENDMENTS AND MODIFICATIONS.** This Agreement may not be amended, modified, or supplemented in any manner, whether by course of conduct or otherwise, except by an instrument in writing specifically designated as an amendment hereto, signed on behalf of each party.
6. **GOVERNING LAW.** This Agreement shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the Republic of the Philippines. Execution, delivery, and performance of this Agreement shall not violate any provision of applicable laws or constitute a breach of any contracts it has entered into.
7. **SEPARABILITY.** If any clause, sentence, or provision of this Agreement shall be declared void or unenforceable by the competent authority, the provision/s unaffected by such declaration shall remain valid and binding among the parties, their successors, and assigns.
